DESCRIPTION:

The Research Institute of Horticulture is looking for a candidate for the assistant position at the Department of Horticultural Plants Cultivation and Nutrition.

Candidate's duties will include: (1) planning, establishing and conducting experimental work in the field of control and cultivation of edible mushrooms, (2) conducting laboratory works and microbiological analyses regarding the identification of microorganisms and the effectiveness of disinfectants, (3) interpretation of the obtained results, along with statistical analysis, (4) preparation of reports and scientific publications on conducted research works.

The Candidate should have higher education and qualifications and skills allowing to achieve the research goals of the Laboratory of Vegetable and Edible Mushroom Cultivation. The Candidate should have experience in conducting laboratory works, including microbiological ones, and have the skills to conduct research in the field of protection and cultivation of edible mushrooms. The scientific achievements in the field of natural and agricultural sciences supported by published manuscripts is welcome. An additional advantage will be experience in the implementation of research projects and grants. Moreover, good command of English is required, including specialized terminology.
