Objectives of the Conference

The Conference, as a joint activity of the EUFRIN "Postharvest and Fruit Quality Working Group" and the Fruit and Vegetable Storage and Processing Department, is organized by the **Research Institute of Horticulture (InHort).**

Major topics of the Conference sessions will be focused on:

- □ Health promoting components of fruits, vegetables and edible ornamentals (vitamins, antioxidants, etc.)
- □ The health benefits of fruit and vegetable consumption (fresh and minimally processed)
- Effects of pre- and post-harvest factors (orchard management, technology of vegetable growing, climate and weather conditions, harvest date, storage technology and shelf-life conditions and duration, and the like) on quality and safety (zero residues) of fruit, vegetables and ornamentals.


Contributed papers and posters, however, do not have to be limited to the above given topics and may address specific subjects and case studies pertinent to fruit, vegetables and ornamentals.

Oral and Poster presentations

The contribution to the conference will be in the form of oral presentations and posters.

The **oral presentations** will be given a time slot of approximately 15 minutes each, including discussion, except for invited speakers and sessions opening lectures. Short discussions will take place at the end of each presentation and at the end of the session, if necessary.

Multimedia projector and laptop computer equipped with USB port and DVD drive (on request) will be available in the conference room. Overhead and slide projectors might be available on request (please let us know in advance). **Posters** should not exceed the maximum dimensions of 95 cm width and 115 cm height.

Abstracts

The abstracts (max. 1 standard page A4 – 1800 characters total) should be written in MS Word editor and sent by e-mail as an attachment file either to Kalina Sikorska-Zimny (kalina.sikorska@inhort.pl) or to Krzysztof Rutkowski (krzysztof.rutkowski@inhort.pl) before April 30, 2019. Authors will be informed about acceptance of the abstract before May 15, 2019.

Conference Venue

All activities of the Conference, except the Professional Tour, will take place in Skierniewice, a small town located in central Poland with about 48,000 inhabitants (2018), situated almost exactly half-way between Lodz and Warsaw, the capital city of Poland (circa 60 km - see the map below). Skierniewice gained municipal rights in 1457. It has a famous railway station, that in the past was a part of historical Warsaw-Vienna Railway. Skierniewice is surrounded by major fruit and vegetable growing regions in Poland. The main fruit growing region, and one of the biggest in Europe and in the world (Grojec), is located about 40 km south-east from Skierniewice. The most important vegetable production regions are located close to Warsaw, Lodz, Lowicz, Leczyca and Sochaczew (70 km from Skierniewice or less).

Nowadays Skierniewice is known as the "Capital City of Polish Horticulture". It houses the Research Institute of Horticulture, established on January 1, 2011, by merging two renown research units, both with long tradition and important achievements in horticultural sciences, namely the Research Institute of Pomology and Floriculture, established in 1951 and organized by professor Szczepan Pieniazek, and the Research Institute of Vegetable Crops, established in 1964 and organized by professor Emil Chroboczek. The new Institute is a legal and organizational successor to its predecessors and inherited their staff and properties as well as rights and obligations. Management of the Institute is located in old Palace, erected in 1610, which was formerly a residence of Polish Primate (bishop) and later of Russian Tsars. The Palace settlement in Skierniewice has a very high historical value for Polish culture.

The Experimental Field of the Department of Agricultural Chemistry of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences (SGGW) and the local College with the Department of Horticultural Sciences are also located in Skierniewice.

Travel and Transport to Skierniewice

By plane:

The airports nearest to Skierniewice are **Warsaw Chopin Airport**: https://en.modlinairport.pl/, and **Lodz Airport**: https://en.modlinairport.pl/, and **Lodz Airport**: http://www.lotnisko.lodz.pl/en/index.html. On their respective Internet pages you can find all the necessary information pertaining to transport from the airport to downtown of Warsaw or Lodz and further to destinations across Poland, including the town of Skierniewice.

By train:

If you are coming to Poland by train you may find direct connections to Skierniewice from some European locations. In most cases, however, your train will arrive to the Central Railway Station (**Warszawa Centralna** in Polish) from where you can easily get to Skierniewice by a number of trains. Fast trains to Skierniewice are leaving from the Central Railway Station (Warszawa Centralna in Polish) or the West Railway Station (Warszawa Zachodnia in Polish) – train destination: Lodz. The trip takes approximately 50 minutes. The most actual time-table (be aware of frequent changes) is available on the web site http://rozklad-pkp.pl/en.

By car:

Skierniewice is located in close proximity (ca 15 km) to international east-west highway **A2** (E30) from Berlin to Warsaw (exit Skierniewice) and to international south-north highway **A1** (E75) – intersection with **A2** in vicinity of Strykow. For other directions use the ordinary roads connecting Skierniewice with highways and local roads.

Visa

A visa to Poland is not necessary for citizens of most European countries. Please check this with your travel agent or with the Polish Embassy/Consulate in your home country, eventually on the web page of the Polish Ministry of Foreign Affairs: https://www.msz.gov.pl/en/travel_to_poland/visa/.

Currency

Polish currency is called 'zloty' (common abbreviation – zl; official bank notation – PLN) and 1 zloty is divided into 100 groszy. The current exchange rate is approximately 1€ = 4.3 zl, 1\$ = 3.8 zl. It is not common practice to pay in foreign currency, but you can easily exchange your money into Polish zloty at the airport, in the banks and exchange

offices (KANTOR). Major credit cards (VISA, MASTERCARD) are accepted at most places, and it is also possible to collect cash from 24hr teller machines (ATMs) located in vicinity of banks and market places.
